Motivational Interviewing:

From Theory to Practice – A Skills Building Learning Program

Workshop participants will be given an overview of Bill Miller and Steve Rollnick's Motivational Interviewing therapy. MI techniques will be demonstrated by the presenters and practiced by the participants. Carlos DiClemente's trans-theoretical stages of change (SOC) model will be explicated for the purpose of understanding the client's intrinsic motivation and choosing the appropriate treatment intervention. Workshop participations will be shown how to apply Motivational Interviewing techniques and the Stages of Change construct to design treatment interventions for clients with drug and alcohol problems. Role plays and application of MI techniques in group and individual treatment will be demonstrated and explored. This is an experiential workshop involving a high degree of participation, homework and reading assignments. **Participants would be asked to attend all 5 workshops.**
